

# Design & Technology Technician

## Purpose of role:

To provide technical support services to the college, including the preparation of materials, and setting up of equipment for class practical sessions and maintaining equipment for use. To work under the instruction /guidance of teaching /senior staff. Expected to perform delegated duties with limited supervision.

## Key accountabilities (and specific duties / responsibilities):

## SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS

- Support both students and Design Technology staff within lessons
- Support students in accessing learning activities under the guidance of the teacher
- Provide feedback to students in relation to progress and achievement.
- Supervise students to safely use machinery

#### SUPPORT FOR THE TEACHER

- To use or prepare equipment/materials as required by teaching staff. To demonstrate and assist students in setting up of, and use of machinery and equipment. To demonstrate skills and techniques as required.
- To manufacture equipment/apparatus, for use in the work area, and ensure its safety for use, as appropriate
- To maintain equipment/apparatus, or arrange for its maintenance, to appropriate Health & Safety, and operational standards
- To prepare materials and equipment for students' use in practical work and examinations, as requested by teaching staff
- To liaise with teaching staff on the availability of materials/equipment for practical examination purposes
- To ensure the maintenance of stock levels, making out initial orders and checking deliveries, liaising with Suppliers as appropriate. To maintain an inventory of machinery, equipment and materials
- To ensure that work areas are maintained in a clean and safe condition appropriate to Health & Safety standards

#### SUPPORT FOR THE CURRICULUM

- Monitor and manage stock and supplies, cataloguing as required
- Preparing materials and equipment / resources to support lessons.
- Creating resources to support GCSE Product Design and AS / A2 level Product Design display / exemplar products / modelling.



- Maintenance of specialist equipment, check for quality/safety, undertake repairs/modifications within own capabilities and report other damages/needs
- Demonstrate and assist others in safe and effective use of specialist equipment/materials
- Undertake structured and agreed learning activities/teaching programmes.
